## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8	Amending the act of November 6, 1987 (P.L.381, No.79), entitled "An act relating to the protection of the abused, neglected, exploited or abandoned elderly; establishing a uniform Statewide reporting and investigative system for suspected abuse, neglect, exploitation or abandonment of the elderly; providing protective services; providing for funding; and making repeals," in administration, providing for Statewide registry of perpetrators of abuse in facilities.
9	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10	hereby enacts as follows:
11	Section 1. The act of November 6, 1987 (P.L.381, No.79),
12	known as the Older Adults Protective Services Act, is amended by
13	adding a section to read:
14	Section 312. Statewide registry of perpetrators of abuse in
15	facilities.
16	(a) EstablishmentThe department shall establish a
17	Statewide registry of persons found to be substantiated
18	perpetrators of abuse, neglect, abandonment or exploitation of
19	<u>older persons in facilities.</u>

1	(b) Information in registryThe registry shall include,
2	but not be limited to, the following:
3	(1) The name, Social Security number, age, sex and
4	address of the perpetrator.
5	(2) The facility or facilities where the perpetrator
6	committed the abuse, neglect, abandonment or exploitation.
7	(3) A description of the abuse, neglect, abandonment or
8	exploitation committed by the perpetrator, including the date
9	or dates of the incidents.
10	(c) ExpungementThe department shall immediately expunge
11	information in the registry pertaining to any perpetrator where
12	the finding of the agency, as defined in 6 Pa. Code § 15.2
13	(relating to definitions), has been reversed upon appeal under 6
14	Pa. Code § 15.82(3) (relating to rights of alleged abusers).
15	(d) Information submitted by prospective employees
16	Administrators of facilities shall require prospective employees
17	to submit with their applications for employment a certification
18	from the department as to whether the applicant is named in the
19	registry as a perpetrator. The certificate must be obtained
20	within the one-year period of the submission date of the
21	application.
22	(e) RegulationsThe department shall promulgate the
23	regulations necessary to carry out this section.
24	(f) ConfidentialityThe department shall comply with
25	sections 306 and 705 with regard to the confidentiality of
26	information contained within the registry.
27	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.

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
