AN ACT

- Designating a portion of County Line Road separating Montgomery County and Bucks County as the SP4 Ronald C. Smith Memorial
- 3 Highway.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. SP4 Ronald C. Smith Memorial Highway.
- 7 (a) Findings.--
- 8 (1) SP4 Ronald Carlton Smith was a resident of Hatboro,
- 9 Pennsylvania, before enlisting in the United States Army on
- December 6, 1967, at 23 years of age.
- 11 (2) SP4 Smith was assigned to Troop E, 1st Cavalry, 11th
- 12 Infantry Brigade, Americal Division of the United States Army
- in Vietnam.
- 14 (3) SP4 Smith served as an Armor Reconnaissance
- 15 Specialist, gathering intelligence on terrain features;

- 1 scouting enemy force strength and locations; driving armored,
- 2 tracked and wheeled vehicles and engaging in tactical
- 3 operations against enemy troops.
- 4 (4) While valiantly serving his country, SP4 Smith was
- 5 killed by an explosive device on April 14, 1968, in the Quang
- 6 Ngai Province of South Vietnam.
- 7 (b) Designation. -- The section of County Line Road separating
- 8 Montgomery and Bucks Counties from Maple Avenue to Easton Road
- 9 is hereby designated the SP4 Ronald C. Smith Memorial Highway.
- 10 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 11 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
- 12 traffic in both directions on the highway.
- 13 Section 2. Effective date.
- 14 This act shall take effect immediately.
