## AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of  
3 dealing in infant children.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 4305 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 4305. Dealing in infant children.

9 (A) OFFENSE DEFINED.--A person is guilty of a [misdemeanor] <--  
10 felony of the first degree if he deals in humanity, by trading,  
11 bartering, buying, selling, or dealing in infant children.

12 (B) DEFINITIONS.--AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE TERM "INFANT <--  
13 CHILD" MEANS A CHILD ONE YEAR OF AGE AND UNDER.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
