- (c) Persons aged 75 years or older.--A person who is exempt 3 or excused from jury duty under section 4503(a)(6) (relating to 4 exemptions from jury duty) may petition the jury selection_ 5 commission to have the person's name placed on the list of 6 disqualified jurors. A person placed on the list may, at any 7 time, petition for removal of the person's name from the list 8 9 unless the person is disqualified under section 4502 (relating to qualifications of jurors). 10
- 11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
