## AN ACT

8	Section 1. Section 121 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
9	No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, added June 30,
10	2012 (P.L.684, No.82), is amended to read:
11	Section 121. Keystone Exams <u>(a)</u> Subject to annual
12	appropriation, not later than the 2020-2021 school year, the
13	Department of Education shall develop and implement Keystone
14	Exams in the following subjects: algebra I, literature, biology,
15	English composition, algebra II, geometry, United States
16	history, chemistry, civics and government and world history. The
17	State Board of Education shall promulgate regulations, subject
18	to the act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181), known as the
19	"Regulatory Review Act," necessary to implement this section.

- 4 regulation to the contrary, neither the Department of Education
- 5 nor the State Board of Education may establish any minimum level
- 6 of student performance on a Keystone Exam as a graduation
- 7 <u>requirement.</u>
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
