AN ACT

- Designating a portion of Pennsylvania Route 144 in Centre County as the PFC Donald Ray Lucas Memorial Highway.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. PFC Donald Ray Lucas Memorial Highway.
- 6 (a) Findings.--
- 7 (1) Private First Class Donald Ray Lucas was born on
- 8 September 6, 1948, and was a native of Centre Hall,
- 9 Pennsylvania.
- 10 (2) PFC Lucas began his sole tour of duty in Vietnam on
- 11 November 15, 1968, as a member of the United States Marine
- 12 Corps.
- 13 (3) PFC Lucas was awarded the Purple Heart, the National
- 14 Defense Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal, the Vietnam
- 15 Campaign Medal and the Combat Action Ribbon.

- 1 (4) On January 12, 1969, PFC Lucas made the ultimate
- 2 sacrifice in selfless service to his nation during combat
- 3 operations in Quang Nam Province.
- 4 (b) Designation. -- The section of Pennsylvania Route 144 in
- 5 Centre County from Old Fort to Potters Mills is hereby
- 6 designated the PFC Donald Ray Lucas Memorial Highway.
- 7 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 8 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
- 9 traffic in both directions on the highway.
- 10 Section 2. Effective date.
- 11 This act shall take effect immediately.
