15	(a) AppropriationThe amount necessary to pay principal of

and interest on all obligations issued to provide funds for
redevelopment assistance capital projects shall be appropriated
from the General Fund and shall be transferred to the Capital
Debt Fund upon authorization by the Governor.

5 (b) Limitation on redevelopment assistance capital project obligations. -- The maximum amount of redevelopment assistance 6 7 capital projects undertaken by the Commonwealth for which 8 obligations are outstanding shall not exceed, in aggregate, \$3,450,000,000. Beginning July 1, 2018, and each July 1 9 thereafter until the sum of the outstanding obligations for 10 redevelopment assistance capital projects equals \$2,950,000,000, 11 the sum of the maximum amount of outstanding obligations for 12 13 redevelopment assistance projects shall be decreased by 14 \$50,000,000. 15 Housing units. -- An amount not to exceed \$50,000,000 of (C) 16 the amount under subsection (b) may be used for the construction

17 of housing units.
