AN ACT

1 Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 75 (Vehicles) of
2 the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in other offenses,
3 repealing provisions relating to violation of governmental
4 rules regarding traffic; and, in rules of the road in
5 general, further providing for prohibitions in specified
6 places.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 7505 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
10 Consolidated Statutes is repealed:

11 [§ 7505. Violation of governmental rules regarding traffic.

12 Each Commonwealth agency shall promulgate rules and
13 regulations governing all vehicular traffic at those
14 Commonwealth facilities situated upon property of the
15 Commonwealth which are within the exclusive jurisdiction of such
16 agency including but not limited to regulations governing the
17 parking of vehicles upon such property. Whoever violates any of
18 the rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this section
19 governing the parking of vehicles shall, upon conviction in a

1 summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding \$5.
2 Whoever violates any of the rules and regulations promulgated
3 pursuant to this section governing the movement of traffic or
4 the operation of vehicles shall, upon conviction in a summary
5 proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding \$15.]

6 Section 2. Section 3353(a)(3) and (e) of Title 75 are
7 amended to read:

8 § 3353. Prohibitions in specified places.

9 (a) General rule.--Except when necessary to avoid conflict
10 with other traffic or to protect the safety of any person or
11 vehicle or in compliance with law or the directions of a police
12 officer or official traffic-control device, no person shall:

13 * * *

14 (3) Park a vehicle:

15 (i) Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad
16 crossing.

17 (ii) At any place where official signs prohibit
18 parking.

19 (iii) At any place within the jurisdiction of a
20 particular Commonwealth agency, including an agency with
21 jurisdiction of the Capitol Complex, where official signs
22 prohibit parking. A person who violates this subparagraph
23 commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be
24 sentenced to pay a fine equal to the fine the person
25 would be subject to in the municipality where the offense
26 occurred. The Department of General Services shall
27 annually publish a schedule of fines in the Pennsylvania
28 Bulletin that applies to jurisdictions under this
29 subparagraph.

1 (e) Penalty.--[Any] Except as set forth in subsection (a)(3)
2 (iii), any person violating any provision of this section is
3 guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be
4 sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$50.

5 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
