- 5 WHEREAS, National Poetry Month seeks to highlight the
- 6 extraordinary legacy and ongoing achievement of American poets,
- 7 introduce Americans to the pleasures and benefits of reading
- 8 poetry, bring poets and poetry to the public in immediate and
- 9 innovative ways and make poetry an important part of our
- 10 children's education; and
- 11 WHEREAS, National Poetry Month, under the leadership and
- 12 direction of the Academy of American Poets, is now the largest
- 13 literary celebration in the world; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Poetry enhances and enriches the lives of all
- 15 Americans; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Poetry, as an essential part of the arts and

- 2 including education, the economy and community pride and
