- 8 WHEREAS, When he graduated from Harbor Creek High School in
- 9 2006, Senior Airman Bell decided to serve his country by joining
- 10 the United States Air Force; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Senior Airman Bell quickly discovered that, although
- 12 he enjoyed firefighting, he loved working with robots and doing
- 13 explosive ordinance disposal, also known as EOD; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Senior Airman Bell attained the level of senior

- 1 airman in the EOD division as an EOD technician by 2012; and
- 2 WHEREAS, On Thursday, January 5, 2012, Senior Airman Bell was
- 3 killed while serving his country in Afghanistan, leaving behind
- 4 his parents, Rick Bell and Donna Aldrich; his stepmother, Kim
- 5 Bell; his sister, Candice Bell; and his wife, Alaina Hart Bell;

- 8 condolences to the family of Senior Airman Bryan Bell, a
- 9 dedicated and valiant soldier, who shall be remembered and
