WHEREAS, The Linfield Fire Company consists of 26 volunteers; and

WHEREAS, The volunteer firefighters of the Linfield Fire Company serve selflessly and tirelessly in order to protect their fellow citizens; and

WHEREAS, In times of uncertainty that Pennsylvanians face today, their commitment and heroics are immeasurable; and WHEREAS, Montgomery County residents salute, admire and appreciate all the volunteers that have served this community for so many years; therefore be it RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives join with the citizens of Montgomery County in recognizing the Linfield Fire Company's 100th anniversary.
