## A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating September 20, 2013, as "POW/MIA Recognition Day" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, POW/MIA Recognition Day is observed across the
4	nation on the third Friday in September each year as a day of
5	remembrance for the speedy and safe return of American prisoners
6	of war (POW) and those still missing in action (MIA); and
7	WHEREAS, The specially recognized day also serves as a call
8	for the return of the remains of fallen soldiers who gave their
9	lives in service to their country; and
10	WHEREAS, The occasion is one of six days on which the
11	Congress of the United States mandates the flying of the POW/MIA
12	flag; and

WHEREAS, Many Americans take the time to pay tribute to those
who were prisoners of war and those who are missing in action,
as well as their families; therefore be it
RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
September 20, 2013, as "POW/MIA Recognition Day" in
Pennsylvania.
