- 3 WHEREAS, NeighborhoodScout has ranked United States cities
- 4 with 25,000 or more residents on the basis of reported crimes
- 5 and population to compile its list of the Top 100 Safest Cities
- 6 in the United States; and
- WHEREAS, According to location-based data and risk analysis
- 8 information used by NeighborhoodScout, Plum Borough is
- 9 considered safer than 79% of cities nationwide; and
- 10 WHEREAS, When compared to other communities Statewide, Plum
- 11 Borough is safer than nearly 61% of cities; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Unity/New Texas neighborhoods have been
- 13 recognized as the safest areas of Plum Borough, followed by
- 14 Renton, Saltsburg Road/New Texas Road, Borough Center, Holiday
- 15 Park and Regency Park; therefore be it
- 16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives, saluting the

- 2 residents and extending best wishes for their continuing efforts
- 3 to enrich the quality of life in their community, honor Plum
