A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of October 20 through 26, 2013, as "National Chemistry Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, National Chemistry Week is an annual event
- 4 designated to raise awareness of the importance of chemistry in
- 5 everyday life and 2013 marks the 26th anniversary of National
- 6 Chemistry Week; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The American Chemical Society coordinates National
- 8 Chemistry Week each year and it is designed to be a community-
- 9 based program that unites the local sections of the society with
- 10 schools, businesses and individuals; and
- 11 WHEREAS, More than 96% of all manufactured goods are directly
- 12 touched by chemistry, making chemistry an essential part of
- 13 every facet of this nation's economy; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The business of chemistry is a significant

- 1 contributor to the economy of this Commonwealth, employing
- 2 nearly 47,000 people; and
- 3 WHEREAS, This year's theme is "Energy: Now and Forever!" and
- 4 will focus on what energy is, how it is produced, and ways to
- 5 identify renewable sources; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The evolving science of chemistry is essential to
- 7 this Commonwealth's industry and the well-being of this
- 8 Commonwealth's citizens, therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 10 week of October 20 through 26, 2013, as "National Chemistry
- 11 Week" in Pennsylvania.
