## A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating the month of March 2014 as "Hibernian Heritage Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, The Ancient Order of Hibernians, the oldest Irish
4	Catholic organization in the United States, was founded
5	concurrently in New York and Pennsylvania in May 1836; and
6	WHEREAS, Members' roots can be traced back 300 years earlier,
7	when their ancestors risked their lives to keep the Irish
8	language, culture and Roman Catholic religion alive in their
9	beloved Ireland; and
10	WHEREAS, The twin goals of the Ancient Order of Hibernians
11	are to assist in the reunification of Ireland and promote Irish
12	culture; and
13	WHEREAS, The Ancient Order of Hibernians seeks to aid the
14	newly arrived Irish, both economically and socially, and is

among the first to welcome new Irish immigrants to the United
States; and

3 WHEREAS, There are more than 80,000 members of the Hibernians 4 in 46 states, Canada and Ireland; and

5 WHEREAS, The Lackawanna County Board of Ancient Order of 6 Hibernians oversees the six divisions of Hibernians across the 7 length and breadth of Lackawanna County, having about 500 8 members; and

9 WHEREAS, Those six honorable divisions that do good works are 10 named: John F. Kennedy, division one of Scranton; Msgr. William 11 Farrell, division two of Carbondale; The O'Neill Brothers, 12 division three of Minooka; Paul Hook O'Malley, division four of 13 West Scranton; Firefighter Joseph Flannery, division five of 14 Taylor; and Father Patrick D. Healey, division six of Scranton; 15 and

16 WHEREAS, The Ancient Order of Hibernians has chapters in the 17 following counties in Pennsylvania: Adams, Allegheny, Berks, 18 Bucks, Cambria, Carbon, Cumberland, Dauphin, Delaware, Lebanon, 19 Lehigh, Luzerne, Lycoming, Monroe, Montgomery, Northampton, 20 Northumberland, Philadelphia, Schuylkill and York that include 21 thousands of members; and

22 WHEREAS, The Ancient Order of Hibernians supports a multitude 23 of charities that improve the quality of life in this 24 Commonwealth and the nation. Those charities include: the 25 Women's Resource Center, myeloma cancer research and various 26 food and clothing banks and pantries, as well as various 27 education scholarships, family assistance programs and veterans' 28 services; therefore be it

29 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the 30 month of March 2014 as "Hibernian Heritage Month" in
