5	WHEREAS, Dog fighting is a form of animal cruelty that
6	persists across America; and
7	WHEREAS, More than 1,000,000 dogs are licensed in this
8	Commonwealth; and
9	WHEREAS, Dogs are "man's best friend," and dog fighting
10	represents the ultimate betrayal of the relationship between
11	humans and dogs; and
12	WHEREAS, Increasing the public's awareness of the signs of
13	dog fighting to encourage the reporting of suspected cases of
14	dog fighting is an important priority; and
15	WHEREAS, The American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty
