A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of May 11 through 17, 2014, as "National
2 Police Week" and May 15, 2014, as "Police Officers' Memorial
3 Day" in Pennsylvania.

4 WHEREAS, Across the United States the week of May 11 through
5 17, 2014, will be recognized as "National Police Week"; and

6 WHEREAS, The first National Police Officers' Memorial Day was
7 held on May 15, 1982, following a proclamation signed by
8 President John F. Kennedy on October 1, 1962, and has continued
9 to be observed annually in memory of those police officers who
10 made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty; therefore be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the memory
12 of the hundreds of police officers who have given their lives in
13 the line of duty in this Commonwealth; and be it further

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
