A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing Tuesday, May 6, 2014, as "The Salvation Army Day in 2 Harrisburg" and commending The Salvation Army in Pennsylvania
- for its legacy of service to the people of this Commonwealth.
- WHEREAS, The Salvation Army in Pennsylvania is a faith-based,
- 5 comprehensive human services organization that has been
- 6 assisting individuals across this Commonwealth since 1879; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The mission of The Salvation Army is to share its
- 8 faith and meet human needs in accordance with this faith without
- 9 discrimination; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In accordance with its mission, The Salvation Army
- 11 takes a holistic approach to providing assistance to
- 12 individuals, families and communities by simultaneously
- 13 addressing physical, emotional, economic and spiritual needs;

- 2 WHEREAS, The Salvation Army delivers a wide array of services
- 3 to residents of this Commonwealth, including hot meals,
- 4 counseling, early childhood development, after-school programs,
- 5 mentoring, disaster relief, drug rehabilitation, job training,
- 6 activities for senior citizens and music and arts programming;

- 8 WHEREAS, The Salvation Army provides assistance to
- 9 Pennsylvanians in every zip code through its 82 Corps community
- 10 centers located across this Commonwealth. The Salvation Army
- 11 aided more than 800,000 individuals and served more than 1.2
- 12 million meals within the past year in Pennsylvania; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Salvation Army has long been a lifeline to
- 14 residents of this Commonwealth, providing vital services in
- 15 times of need such as during the economic recession and recent
- 16 winter storms; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Every two years, members of The Salvation Army from
- 18 around this Commonwealth assemble at the State Capitol in
- 19 Harrisburg to meet with State legislators. The purpose of this
- 20 biennial visit is to update legislators on The Salvation Army's
- 21 programs and advise them about constituent needs in their
- 22 respective districts. This event is also an opportunity for
- 23 legislators to meet their local Salvation Army leaders and
- 24 witness the reach and scope of this organization's services to
- 25 Pennsylvanians; and
- 26 WHEREAS, The Salvation Army's next biennial event, entitled
- 27 The Salvation Army Day in Harrisburg will occur on Tuesday, May
- 28 6, 2014; therefore be it
- 29 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize
- 30 Tuesday, May 6, 2014, as "The Salvation Army Day in Harrisburg"
