A RESOLUTION

- Designating the weeks of August 24, 2014, through August 30, 2014, and August 31, 2014, through September 6, 2014, as "Back to School Weeks" in Pennsylvania.
- 4 WHEREAS, The Constitution of Pennsylvania declares that the
- 5 General Assembly shall provide for the maintenance and support
- 6 of a thorough and efficient system of public education to serve
- 7 the needs of the students and families of this Commonwealth; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Education is a primary concern of the Commonwealth
- 9 and the members of the House of Representatives, who are
- 10 instrumental in assuring the quality of Pennsylvania schools;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives supports education
- 13 initiatives that foster healthy intellectual and educational
- 14 development among students, and
- 15 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is comprised of more than 500 school
- 16 districts, with more than 5,500 schools educating students from

- 1 kindergarten through 12th grade; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Back to school week marks the official end of summer
- 3 and the start of a new and challenging school year for students,
- 4 parents, teachers and school administrations; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives encourages and supports
- 6 students across this Commonwealth to embrace learning and to
- 7 enjoy the school year ahead; therefore be it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 9 weeks of August 24, 2014, through August 30, 2014, and August
- 10 31, 2014, through September 6, 2014, as "Back to School Weeks"
- 11 in Pennsylvania.
