## A RESOLUTION

Designating the weeks of August 24, 2014, through August 30, 2014, and August 31, 2014, through September 6, 2014, as "Back to School Weeks" in Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, The Constitution of Pennsylvania declares that the General Assembly shall provide for the maintenance and support of a thorough and efficient system of public education to serve the needs of the students and families of this Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, Education is a primary concern of the Commonwealth and the members of the House of Representatives, who are instrumental in assuring the quality of Pennsylvania schools; and

WHEREAS, The House of Representatives supports education initiatives that foster healthy intellectual and educational development among students, and

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is comprised of more than 500 school districts, with more than 5,500 schools educating students from
kindergarten through 12th grade; and
WHEREAS, Back to school week marks the official end of summer and the start of a new and challenging school year for students, parents, teachers and school administrations; and

WHEREAS, The House of Representatives encourages and supports students across this Commonwealth to embrace learning and to enjoy the school year ahead; therefore be it
