A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring Austin Shupp for his outstanding athletic performance
2 and his achievement of winning four medals at the 2014 State
3 track and field championship.

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Shupp attended Palmerton Area High School and is
5 currently attending Shippensburg University; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Shupp participated in track and field during his
7 high school career and excelled in sports because of his
8 athletic ability; and

9 WHEREAS, While in high school, Mr. Shupp was a member of the
10 environment club and student council, along with achieving
11 athletic success by being a four-year letter winner in soccer
12 and holding his high school's all-time scoring record in soccer;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Shupp was a four-year varsity letter athlete in
15 track and field at his high school, where he holds records in
16 the 300 meter hurdles, 110 meter hurdles, triple jump, 4x400
17 meter relay and 4x100 meter relay; and

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Shupp has been named two times as outstanding
2 male track athlete of the year, named to the all-State
3 Pennsylvania track and field team for the 100 and 300 meter
4 hurdles and is a State Games of America champion in the 100 and
5 400 meter hurdles; and

6 WHEREAS, At the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic
7 Association (PIAA) track and field championships, Mr. Shupp won
8 four medals, including gold in the AA class 110 meter high
9 hurdles and silver in the 300 meter high hurdles; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Shupp made the National Federation Honor Roll
11 for the 300 meter hurdles, with a qualifying time of 37.98; and

12 WHEREAS, Along with his teammates, Mr. Shupp helped to claim
13 third place in the 1600 meter relay at the PIAA track and field
14 championships; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Shupp earned a medal as a member of the 400-
16 meter relay team at the PIAA track and field championships;
17 therefore be it

18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor Austin
19 Shupp for his outstanding athletic performance and his
20 achievement of winning four medals at the 2014 State track and
21 field championship.
