A RESOLUTION

- 1 Encouraging support for pediatric brain tumor research.
- 2 WHEREAS, Brain tumors are the second leading cause of cancer-
- 3 related deaths in children who are under 20 years of age; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The most common form of childhood brain tumors is
- 5 pediatric low-grade astrocytoma (PLGA), a slow growing,
- 6 potentially fatal tumor; and
- 7 WHEREAS, PLGAs account for one-third of pediatric brain
- 8 tumors; and
- 9 WHEREAS, PLGAs remain significantly underresearched, and
- 10 first-line treatment has remained unchanged for over 25 years;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, The diagnosis of brain tumors in children has an
- 13 overwhelming effect on families; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Treatment of a brain tumor is oftentimes a lengthy

- 1 and painful process with no guarantee of being cured; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Parent support, patient support, sibling support and
- 3 financial support are a necessity when enduring the effects of
- 4 treatment; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Survival rates for children with brain tumors have
- 6 increased over the past 30 years, but survivors are left with
- 7 lifelong side effects; and
- 8 WHEREAS, To enhance the quality of life children with brain
- 9 tumors need the same opportunities for social and educational
- 10 growth as other children; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Increasing public awareness of the significance and
- 12 effects of pediatric brain tumors is a critical component in the
- 13 fight to find a cure; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Why Not Me, Inc., is a nonprofit organization
- 15 established to support research and raise awareness of brain
- 16 tumors in young people, in particular, research that will lead
- 17 to a cure for PLGAs; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Why Not Me, Inc., and similar organizations deserve
- 19 recognition for their efforts to increase awareness of the need
- 20 for pediatric brain tumor research; therefore be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage support
- 22 for pediatric brain tumor research and call upon residents of
- 23 this Commonwealth to promote awareness of pediatric brain
- 24 tumors, foster an understanding of the impact of pediatric brain
- 25 tumors and take an active role in the fight to end pediatric
- 26 brain tumors.
