9	Section 1. Section 2004-C(c) of the act of March 10, 1949
10	(P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
11	amended by adding a paragraph to read:

14	(c) Duties of Transfer and Articulation Oversight
15	CommitteeThe committee shall:

17	(6) Within 180 days of the effective date of this
18	paragraph and in consultation with faculty and personnel and
19	the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, submit a

1	report to the department, the Education Committee of the
2	Senate, the Education Committee of the House of
3	Representatives, the Appropriations Committee of the Senate
4	and the Appropriations Committee of the House of
5	Representatives assessing the feasibility of developing
6	uniform standards and methods to grant academic credit for
7	experience, education and training obtained during military
8	service in order to expedite undergraduate degree
9	requirements for veterans and service members. The report
10	shall include:
11	(i) Recommendations relating to the process to
12	enable the transfer of the credits between institutions
13	to ensure that credits will be applied toward graduation
14	<u>requirements.</u>
15	(ii) Recommendations for amendments to this act
16	deemed necessary by the committee.
17	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
