AN ACT

1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for additional
3 points in grading civil service examinations.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 7103(a) of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 7103. Additional points in grading civil service
9 examinations.

10 (a) Commonwealth examinations.--Whenever any soldier shall
11 successfully pass a civil service appointment or promotional
12 examination for a public position under this Commonwealth, or
13 any political subdivision thereof, and shall thus establish that
14 he possesses the qualifications required by law for appointment
15 to or promotion in such public position, such soldier's
16 examination shall be marked or graded an additional [ten] 15
17 points above the mark or grade credited for the examination, and

1 the total mark or grade thus obtained shall represent the final
2 mark or grade of such soldier, and shall determine his standing
3 on any eligible or promotional list, certified or furnished to
4 the appointing or promoting power.

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
