AN ACT

- 1 Requiring the notification of breast density to patients who 2 receive a mammogram.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Breast
- 7 Density Notification Act.
- 8 Section 2. Breast density notification and information
- 9 provided.
- 10 (a) Inclusion of density information. -- Each mammography
- 11 report provided to a patient by a mammography facility certified
- 12 by the United States Food and Drug Administration shall include
- 13 the patient's breast density information based on the Breast
- 14 Imaging Reporting and Data System established by the American
- 15 College of Radiology.
- 16 (b) Notice. -- The report shall also include the following
- 17 notice:

- 1 If your mammogram demonstrates you have dense breast tissue,
- which could hide abnormalities, and you have other risk
- 3 factors for breast cancer that have been identified, you
- 4 might benefit from supplemental screening tests that may be
- 5 suggested by your referring physician. A report of your
- 6 mammography results, which contains information about your
- 7 breast density, has been sent to your referring physician's
- 8 office and you should contact him or her if you have any
- 9 questions or concerns about your breast density or this
- 10 report.
- 11 Section 3. Effective date.
- 12 This act shall take effect in 90 days.
