1 (2) (3) Six representatives of community colleges, <--2 including four college presidents and two members of boards 3 of trustees of community colleges to be appointed by the Pennsylvania Commission for Community Colleges. 4 5 (3) (4) Two members of the Senate to be appointed by the <--6 President pro tempore of the Senate. 7 Two members of the House of Representatives to $\frac{(4)}{(5)}$ 8 be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. 9 (5) (6) One county commissioner that represents a county <--10 that sponsors a local community college as appointed by the 11 Secretary of Education GOVERNOR. <--12 (6) (7) One member of a school board that sponsors a <--13 local community college as appointed by the Secretary of <--14 Education GOVERNOR. <--15 Two representatives to be appointed by the $\frac{(7)}{(8)}$ <--16 Governor who are members of the business community. 17 (8) (9) Two students, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, WHO ARE <--18 attending community colleges as appointed by the Pennsylvania <--19 Commission for Community Colleges. 20 (9) (10) Two faculty members, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, <--21 WHO ARE employed by community colleges as appointed by the 22 Pennsylvania Commission for Community Colleges. 23 (11)ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A COMMUNITY EDUCATION <--24 COUNCIL, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR. 25 Study. -- The task force COUNCIL shall examine and make <--26 recommendations regarding the viability and sustainability of 27 the current community college funding model, accessibility of 28 community college services across this Commonwealth, and the 29 long-term affordability and accessibility of a community college education for residents of this Commonwealth. - 17 (f) Compensation.--Task force COUNCIL members shall receive <--
- 18 no compensation for their services but shall be reimbursed for
- 19 all necessary travel and other reasonable expenses incurred in
- 20 connection with the performance of their duties as members.
- 21 (q) Duties of department. -- The Department of Education shall
- 22 provide administrative support, office space and any other

- 25 Section 2. Effective date. EXPIRATION.
- 26 THIS ACT SHALL EXPIRE NOVEMBER 30, 2014, UNLESS REENACTED
- 27 SOONER.
- 28 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.
