- 14 Cosmetic Act[.], 18 Pa.C.S. (relating to crimes and offenses)
- 15 and 75 Pa.C.S. (relating to vehicles). In appropriate cases, the

- 17 proceeds from forfeited property to be utilized by community-
- based drug and crime-fighting programs and for relocation and 18
