AN ACT

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1	Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled

11	elections," further providing for Voting Standards
12	Development Board.

15	Section 1. Section 204(h) of the act of June 3, 1937
16	(P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code,

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19	(h) (1) The board shall have the power and duty to develop
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20	uniform and nondiscriminatory standards that define what
21	constitutes a valid vote cast through a paper ballot and what

system used in the Commonwealth. On or before July 1, 2003, the
board shall adopt standards for paper ballots and each type of
electronic voting system. The department shall cause these
standards to be published as a notice in the Pennsylvania
Bulletin.

The standards adopted by the board and published by the 6 (2) 7 Department of State in the Pennsylvania Bulletin Volume 33 8 Number 31 on August 2, 2003, shall[, for the general election in 9 2004 and any primary, municipal, special and general election in 10 2006, 2007, 2009 and, 2010, 2011 and 2012,] have the force and effect of law[.] UNTIL SUCH TIME AS A CATEGORY OF VOTING SYSTEM, <--11 OTHER THAN THE PAPER BALLOT OR ELECTRONIC VOTING SYSTEM AS_ 12 DEFINED IN SECTION 1101-A, IS APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY FOR USE 13 14 IN THIS COMMONWEALTH UNDER SECTION 201(B). THE SECRETARY SHALL 15 PUBLISH THE APPROVAL AS A NOTICE IN THE PENNSYLVANIA BULLETIN. 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
