AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in school health services, further
- 6 providing for automatic external defibrillators.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 1423 of the act of March 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, added
- 11 May 17, 2001 (P.L.4, No.4), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 1423. Automatic External Defibrillators.--[(a) For
- 13 the fiscal year 2001-2002, the department shall establish a one-
- 14 time automatic external defibrillator program to assist school
- 15 entities in acquiring automatic external defibrillators.]
- 16 (a.1) Each school entity shall provide for and maintain an
- 17 <u>automatic external defibrillator in each instructional school</u>
- 18 <u>building for use during emergencies</u>.
- 19 (a.2) (1) The department shall establish an automatic

- 1 <u>external defibrillator program to assist school entities and</u>
- 2 <u>nonpublic schools in acquiring automatic external</u>
- 3 defibrillators.
- 4 (2) A school entity or a nonpublic school shall notify the
- 5 <u>department in the manner specified by the department that it</u>
- 6 <u>elects to participate in the program established by this</u>
- 7 subsection.
- 8 (3) No school entity or nonpublic school shall be required
- 9 to participate in the automatic external defibrillator program.
- 10 (b) (1) The department, in consultation with the Department
- 11 of General Services, shall issue an invitation to bid for the
- 12 cost of automatic external defibrillators. The department shall
- 13 accept the bid of the lowest responsible bidder and permit any
- 14 school entity or nonpublic school participating in the program
- 15 to purchase the devices at the contract bid price in numbers
- 16 <u>sufficient to provide for one device in each instructional</u>
- 17 school building that does not currently have an operational
- 18 <u>device</u>.
- 19 (2) The department shall credit the amount provided under
- 20 subsection (i.3) to permit school entities participating in the
- 21 program to purchase devices at a price below the contract bid
- 22 price.
- 23 (c) To be eligible to obtain or purchase automatic external
- 24 defibrillators under the program a school entity must:
- 25 (1) Assure that two (2) or more [persons] school employes
- 26 assigned to the location where the automatic external
- 27 defibrillator will be [primarily housed] <u>located</u> are trained as
- 28 required in subsection (d) and that one of the trained school
- 29 <u>employes shall be available at all school-sponsored activities</u>
- 30 conducted after regular school hours in the instructional school

- 1 building and on school grounds.
- 2 (2) Ensure that the device will be secured in a safe and
- 3 readily accessible location and agree to properly maintain and
- 4 test the device according to the manufacturer's operational
- 5 guidelines.
- 6 (3) Submit a valid prescription for the device from a
- 7 licensed medical practitioner in this Commonwealth.
- 8 (4) Agree to provide the training required by subsection
- 9 (d).
- 10 (d) School [personnel] employes who are expected to use the
- 11 automatic external defibrillator shall complete training in
- 12 cardiopulmonary resuscitation and in the use of an automatic
- 13 external defibrillator provided by the American Heart
- 14 Association, the American Red Cross or through an equivalent
- 15 course of instruction approved by the Department of Health.
- 16 (e) A school entity may include the training required by
- 17 subsection (d) in its continuing professional education plan
- 18 submitted to the department under section 1205.1.
- 19 (f) The provisions of 42 Pa.C.S. § 8331.2 (relating to good
- 20 Samaritan civil immunity for use of automated external
- 21 defibrillator) shall apply to school employes who render care
- 22 with an automatic external defibrillator.
- [(g) From funds appropriated for this purpose, the
- 24 department, upon request, shall provide: up to two (2) automatic
- 25 external defibrillators to each school district; one (1)
- 26 automatic external defibrillator to each intermediate unit; and
- 27 one (1) automatic external defibrillator to each area
- 28 vocational-technical school.
- 29 (h) No school entity shall be required to participate in the
- 30 automatic external defibrillator program.

- 1 (i) No later than June 30, 2002, the secretary shall submit
- 2 a report to the General Assembly describing the effectiveness of
- 3 this section in outfitting the Commonwealth's school entities
- 4 with automatic external defibrillators.]
- 5 (i.1) The department, upon request, shall permit each school
- 6 entity and nonpublic school to participate in the program.
- 7 (i.2) The department shall enforce the provisions of this
- 8 section.
- 9 (i.3) (i) The sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) is
- 10 appropriated to the department from the Tobacco Settlement Fund
- 11 <u>established in section 303(a) of the act of June 26, 2001</u>
- 12 (P.L.755, No.77), known as the Tobacco Settlement Act, to assist
- 13 school entities participating in the program to purchase
- 14 <u>automatic external defibrillators as provided in this section.</u>
- 15 <u>(ii) The department shall use the appropriation to reduce</u>
- 16 the per unit purchase price of an automatic external
- 17 defibrillator purchased by a school entity below the contract
- 18 bid price.
- 19 (iii) Of the amount appropriated in subparagraph (i), two
- 20 million eight hundred seventy-three thousand eight hundred
- 21 dollars (\$2,873,800) shall be allocated to participating school
- 22 districts in the same percentage as the school district received
- 23 for basic education funding in the prior school year. Any funds
- 24 remaining under this paragraph following the completion of the
- 25 initial allocation under this subparagraph and any funds
- 26 received from under subparagraph (vii) shall be allocated to
- 27 participating school districts on a pro rata basis.
- 28 <u>(iv) Of the amount appropriated in subparagraph (i), twenty-</u>
- 29 two thousand four hundred dollars (\$22,400) shall be apportioned
- 30 to participating intermediate units in a percentage equal to the

- 1 <u>sum of all percentages of basic education funding received in</u>
- 2 the prior school year by each school district served by the
- 3 participating intermediate unit.
- 4 (v) Of the amount appropriated in subparagraph (i), thirty-
- 5 one thousand three hundred dollars (\$31,300) shall be allocated
- 6 to participating area vocational technical schools on a pro rata
- 7 basis, provided that no apportionment to a participating area
- 8 <u>vocational technical school shall exceed a total amount that is</u>
- 9 equivalent to four hundred fifty dollars (\$450) per unit.
- 10 (vi) Of the amount appropriated in subparagraph (i), sixty-
- 11 eight thousand dollars (\$68,000) shall be allocated to
- 12 participating charter schools on a pro rata basis, provided that
- 13 no apportionment to a participating charter school shall exceed
- 14 a total amount that is equivalent to four hundred fifty dollars
- 15 (\$450) per unit.
- 16 (vii) Of the amount appropriated in subparagraph (i), Four
- 17 thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500) shall be allocated to
- 18 participating cyber charter schools on a pro rata basis,
- 19 provided that no apportionment to a participating cyber charter
- 20 school shall exceed a total amount that is equivalent to four
- 21 hundred fifty dollars (\$450) per unit.
- 22 (viii) Any funds remaining in subparagraphs (iii), (iv), (v)
- 23 or (vi) following the allocation under those subparagraphs shall
- 24 be reallocated to participating school districts as provided
- 25 under subparagraph (ii).
- 26 (j) The department may adopt quidelines as necessary to
- 27 administer this section.
- 28 (k) As used in this section--
- 29 "Automatic external defibrillator" means a portable device
- 30 that uses electric shock to restore a stable heart rhythm to an

- 1 individual in cardiac arrest.
- 2 "Department" means the Department of Education of the
- 3 Commonwealth.
- 4 "School entity" means an area vocational-technical school, a
- 5 charter school, an intermediate unit, a nonpublic school or a
- 6 school district.
- 7 "Secretary" means the Secretary of Education of the
- 8 Commonwealth.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
