AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge to be constructed on that portion of State  
2 Route 222 over the Amtrak rail lines in the City of  
3 Lancaster, Lancaster County, replacing the Lititz Pike  
4 Bridge, as the Thaddeus Stevens Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Thaddeus Stevens Bridge.

8 (a) Designation.--The bridge to be constructed on State  
9 Route 222 in the City of Lancaster, Lancaster County, over the  
10 Amtrak rail lines, replacing the Lititz Pike Bridge, is hereby  
11 designated as the Thaddeus Stevens Bridge.

12 (b) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and  
13 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to  
14 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

15 Section 2. Effective date.

16 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
