1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to elections," providing for early voting in primaries and elections.
13	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14	hereby enacts as follows:
15	Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known
16	as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by adding an
17	article to read:
18	ARTICLE XII-A
19	CONDUCT OF EARLY VOTING
20	IN PRIMARIES AND ELECTIONS
21	Section 1201-A. Early voting period.
2.2	The county heard of each county shall provide for early

- 1 voting to begin 15 days prior to the dates of elections and
- 2 primaries established in accordance with Article VI and to end
- 3 14 days after the starting date.
- 4 <u>Section 1202-A. Early voting sites.</u>
- 5 The county board of each county shall designate early voting
- 6 <u>sites where electors may cast their ballots during the early</u>
- 7 <u>voting period established in accordance with section 1201-A.</u>
- 8 These sites shall include the main office of the county board
- 9 and any other sites designated by the county board. The county
- 10 board shall make available at these sites the same equipment
- 11 used on election day as provided for in Article XI. The early
- 12 voting sites shall be geographically located to provide electors
- 13 <u>in the election district an equal opportunity to cast a ballot.</u>
- 14 Section 1203-A. Days and times for opening and closing polls at
- early voting sites.
- 16 The county board of each county shall designate the days and
- 17 hours that early voting sites will be open, provided that all
- 18 sites throughout the county shall have uniform days and hours,
- 19 shall be open eight hours each weekday, shall be open a minimum
- 20 of an aggregate eight hours each weekend, and shall not open
- 21 prior to 7 p.m. Eastern Standard Time or close before 7 p.m.
- 22 Eastern Standard Time.
- 23 Section 1204-A. Voting check list.
- 24 The county board shall maintain a voting check list as
- 25 provided for in section 1212 in such a way to ensure that
- 26 electors are prohibited from casting additional ballots at
- 27 <u>either an early voting site or on election day in their</u>
- 28 precinct.
- 29 Section 1205-A. Disposition of returns.
- The county board shall track votes by precinct but shall not

- 1 tabulate votes prior to the close of the polls on election day.
- 2 <u>Section 1206-A. Notice of early voting.</u>
- 3 The county board of each county shall, not earlier than 15
- 4 days nor later than nine days before each November election,
- 5 give notice of early voting by newspaper publication in the
- 6 county in accordance with the provisions of section 106, the
- 7 notice to be published twice in counties of the first class and
- 8 once in all other counties. The county board shall also post the
- 9 <u>notice on its publicly accessible Internet website.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
