AN ACT

1 Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled, as
 2 reenacted and amended, "An act concerning townships of the
 3 second class; and amending, revising, consolidating and
 4 changing the law relating thereto," further providing for
 5 township manager, appointment, removal, powers and duties,
 6 compensation and bond; and providing for evasion of
 7 requirements.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 1301 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103,
 11 No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, reenacted and
 12 amended November 9, 1995 (P.L.350, No.60), is amended by adding
 13 a subsection to read:

14 Section 1301. Township Manager; Appointment, Removal, Powers
 15 and Duties; Compensation; Bond.--* * *

16 (d) No individual shall be appointed to the office of
 17 township manager in the township in which he was elected to
 18 serve as township supervisor until ninety days after the date he
 19 left the office, whether by expiration of a term, resignation or
 20 for any other reason.

21 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:

1 Section 1302. Evasion of Requirements.--No supervisor shall
2 vote to evade the requirements of this article by appointing or
3 employing a person in a capacity substantially similar to that
4 of the township manager except as provided in section 1301.

5 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
