AN ACT

1 Designating the bridge carrying PA Route 973 over Hoagland Run
2 in Lycoming Township, Lycoming County, as the Bruce E.
3 Bartley, Sr., Bridge.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Bruce E. Bartley, Sr., Bridge.

7 (a) Findings and declarations.--The General Assembly finds
8 and declares as follows:

9 (1) Bruce E. Bartley, Sr., was born on September 6,
10 1923, in Lycoming County.

11 (2) Mr. Bartley was drafted in the United States Army in
12 1942 where he fought in five major campaigns.

13 (3) Mr. Bartley earned the rank of Corporal T-5 until
14 his honorable discharge in 1945.

15 (4) Mr. Bartley married the former Mildred Hornberger.

16 (5) He served as a Lycoming Township Supervisor from
17 1953 until 1961.

18 (6) Mr. Bartley was a member of St. Michael's Church in
19 Quiggleville, as well as many community and professional

1 organizations, including being member and past president of
2 the St. Michael's Cemetery Association and The Grand Lodge of
3 Free and Accepted Masons of Pennsylvania since 1964.

4 (7) He has volunteered extensively over the years and is
5 a respected member of his community.

6 (8) Mr. Bartley is the father of four children and eight
7 grandchildren.

8 (9) Mr. Bartley currently resides on the family farm
9 where he was born.

10 (b) Designation.--The bridge carrying PA Route 973 over
11 Hoagland Run in Lycoming Township, Lycoming County, is hereby
12 designated and shall be known as the Bruce E. Bartley, Sr.,
13 Bridge.

14 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
15 maintain appropriate signs to traffic both directions to
16 indicate the designation under subsection (b).

17 Section 2. Effective date.

18 This act shall take effect immediately.
