AN ACT

1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for resident license and fee
3 exemptions.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 2706(b) of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 2706. Resident license and fee exemptions.

9 * * *

10 (b) Disabled veterans.--

11 (1) Any resident disabled veteran of any war or armed
12 conflict whose physical disability consists of the loss of
13 one or more limbs, or the loss of the use of one or more
14 limbs, or whose physical disability is considered total,
15 including a veteran who under Federal regulations is assigned
16 a disability rating of less than total but who is deemed 100%
17 disabled due to unemployability, and who meets all other

1 qualifications of this title and is otherwise mentally and
2 physically fit, shall be issued a regular hunting or
3 furtaking license upon application to any county treasurer,
4 without the payment of the license cost, if that person is
5 domiciled in this Commonwealth.

6 (2) The application for the issuance of this license
7 shall, in addition to the other information required by the
8 director, contain a statement that the applicant is a war or
9 armed conflict veteran and that his physical disability was
10 service incurred.

11 (3) The applicant shall produce the applicant's
12 discharge papers and a Department of Veterans Affairs
13 disability certification to the effect that the applicant
14 suffers total physical disability.

15 (4) If a disabled veteran who qualifies for issuance of
16 a license under this subsection presents documentation to
17 show that the qualifying disability is permanent, the county
18 treasurer shall issue the disabled veteran a lifetime hunting
19 or furtaking license.

20 (5) In a county where there is no county treasurer by
21 virtue of a home rule charter or optional plan of government,
22 the county official who performs the functions of a county
23 treasurer and who has been designated an issuing agent by the
24 commission shall issue licenses under this subsection.

26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
