## AN ACT

Amending the act of October 15, 1980 (P.L.950, No.164), entitled 1 "A supplement to the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), 2 entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct 3 of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth 4 by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 9 10 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 20 commissions shall be determined," implementing the addition of section 4.1 to Article IV of the Constitution of 21 22 Pennsylvania; establishing the Office of Attorney General 23 elected by the citizens and setting forth powers and duties 24 of the Attorney General; creating an Office of General 25 Counsel and providing for legal services for Commonwealth 26 agencies; transferring, reorganizing or reconstituting 27 certain boards, commissions and agencies; placing certain 28 duties upon the courts and district attorneys; repealing 29 certain acts and parts of acts and making appropriations," 30 further providing for legal advice and civil matters. 31

32 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

1 hereby enacts as follows:

2	Section 1. Section 204 of the act of October 15, 1980
3	(P.L.950, No.164), known as the Commonwealth Attorneys Act, is
4	amended by adding a subsection to read:
5	Section 204. Legal advice and civil matters.
6	* * *
7	(c.1) Reimbursement for costs of collection
8	(1) All reasonable costs of collection of debts, taxes
9	and accounts due the Commonwealth incurred by the Attorney
10	General must be paid before the liability is extinguished
11	unless collection costs are discharged by operation of law.
12	The costs of collection may be added to the amount of the
13	liability and shall constitute a lien against the real or
14	personal property of the person liable. The unpaid costs may
15	be collected by the Attorney General, the political
16	subdivision where the debt originated or a private collection
17	agency.
18	(2) Collection costs of the Office of Attorney General
19	may not exceed 5% of the principal amount of the debt, taxes
20	or accounts due to and collected by the Commonwealth.
21	(3) Costs incurred by private collection agencies may
22	not be included in the collection costs of the Office of
23	<u>Attorney General.</u>
24	(4) Moneys collected pursuant to this subsection shall
25	only be used for the operating expenses of debt collection
26	efforts by the Office of Attorney General.
27	(5) For purposes of this subsection, costs of collection
28	shall include only the following:
29	(i) Lien filing costs.
30	(ii) Remuneration to the Attorney General to collect

1	debts, taxes and accounts due to and collected by the
2	Commonwealth.
3	(iii) Remuneration to a private collection agency
4	authorized by the Attorney General to collect debts,
5	taxes and accounts due the Commonwealth.
6	* * *
7	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
