AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge on that portion of S.R. 35 over the Juniata
2 River in Juniata County as the Juniata County Veterans
3 Memorial Bridge.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Juniata County Veterans Memorial Bridge.

7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds as follows:

8 (1) Juniata County wishes to honor the citizens of the
9 county who have served or are currently serving our nation in
10 the armed forces.

11 (2) Juniata County residents served in every major
12 United States military conflict going back to the Civil War.

13 (3) More than 5,000 people from Juniata County have
14 served in defense of the United States.

15 (4) The bridge displays 12 flags, six representing the
16 United States, five representing the five branches of the
17 military and one flag remembering prisoners of war or
18 soldiers who are missing in action.

19 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on S.R. 35 in Juniata

1 County over the Juniata River is hereby designated as the
2 Juniata County Veterans Memorial Bridge.

3 (c) Signs.---The Department of Transportation shall erect
4 and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge
5 to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

6 Section 2. Effective date.

7 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
