AN ACT

1 Designating the interchange between the portion of State Route
2 3009 and State Route 119 in South Union Township, Fayette
3 County, as the Fred L. Lebder Interchange.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Fred L. Lebder Interchange.

7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds as follows:

8 (1) Fred L. Lebder was born on August 1, 1920, in
9 Collier, Fayette County, as the ninth of ten children.

10 (2) Mr. Lebder was an athlete at Georges Township High
11 School who graduated from the California State Teachers
12 College and taught at Point Marion and Georges High Schools.
13 He served in the Air Force for 41 months during World War II.

14 (3) Mr. Lebder married the former Norma Jean Cole in
15 1943.

16 (4) Mr. Lebder has been actively involved in public
17 affairs in Fayette County for 34 years. He served as a
18 Fayette County commissioner for 28 years and as chairman of
19 the Fayette County Board of Commissioners for 20 years.

1 (5) Mr. Lebder has earned the respect and admiration of
2 the citizens of Fayette County through both his commitment to
3 numerous volunteer organizations and dedicated public service
4 career.

5 (b) Designation.--The intersection between the portion of
6 State Route 3009 and State Route 119 in South Union Township,
7 Fayette County, is hereby designated the Fred L. Lebder
8 Interchange.

9 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
10 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the
11 interchange to traffic in both directions on the interchange.
12 Section 2. Effective date.

13 This act shall take effect immediately.
