AN ACT

1 Designating the portion of State Route 51, known as Fleming Park  
2 Road, that intersects with Coraopolis Road in Kennedy  
3 Township, Allegheny County, as the Captain Sean M. Ruane  
4 Memorial Highway.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Captain Sean M. Ruane Memorial Highway.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as  
9 follows:

10 (1) Captain Sean M. Ruane, a highly decorated combat  
11 veteran, was born October 11, 1982, and graduated from  
12 Montour High School in 2000 and Embry Riddle Aeronautical  
13 University in 2005.

14 (2) Upon graduation, Captain Ruane entered the United  
15 States Air Force and became a pilot.

16 (3) Captain Ruane was deployed five times to the  
17 battlefields of Iraq and Afghanistan.

18 (4) Captain Ruane was assigned to the 56th Rescue

Squadron at the Royal Air Force's Lakenheath base in England.

(5) On January 7, 2014, Captain Ruane paid the supreme sacrifice while serving his country when the plane in which he was instructing fellow airmen crashed in eastern England.

(b) Designation.--The section of State Route 51, known as Fleming Park Road, that intersects with Coraopolis Road in Kennedy Township, Allegheny County, is hereby designated as the Captain Sean M. Ruane Memorial Highway.

(c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to traffic in both directions on the highway.

Section 2. Effective date.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.
