A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of January 27 through February 1, 2013, as
2 "Catholic Schools Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Catholic schools in this Commonwealth are
4 celebrating "Catholic Schools Week" during the week beginning
5 January 27, 2013; and

6 WHEREAS, The theme for this year is "Catholic Schools: Faith,
7 Academics, Service"; and

8 WHEREAS, Catholic elementary and secondary schools educate
9 approximately 153,000 students annually and save State and local
10 taxpayers more than \$2 billion each year; and

11 WHEREAS, Catholic schools instill in young people a strong
12 foundation of values, self-esteem, self-confidence and
13 leadership skills; and

14 WHEREAS, Catholic schools, in providing young people with a
15 strong foundation of the values and academic skills needed in

1 becoming responsible citizens of this Commonwealth and this
2 nation have a drop-out rate of less than 3% and a postgraduate
3 higher education rate of 90%; therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of January 27
5 through February 1, 2013, as "Catholic Schools Week" in
6 Pennsylvania and express congratulations and appreciation to
7 Catholic elementary and secondary schools across this
8 Commonwealth on the occasion of Catholic Schools Week in 2013.
