A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing March 13, 2013, as "Pennsylvania Industrial Resource Centers (IRCs) Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The seven Pennsylvania Industrial Resource Centers
- 4 (IRCs) located strategically throughout this Commonwealth and
- 5 their dedicated staff members help small and medium-sized
- 6 manufacturing enterprises respond to changing markets, new
- 7 technology and the competitive pressure of the global economy;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, Small and medium-sized manufacturers are critical to
- 10 the health and prosperity of the Pennsylvania economy and make
- 11 up over 92% of the manufacturing establishments in Pennsylvania;
- 12 and
- 13 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania IRCs have provided sustained
- 14 performance through more than 30,000 projects for more than
- 15 9,200 firms since 1988; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania IRCs work with hundreds of closely

- 1 aligned professional manufacturing consultants that serve every
- 2 corner of Pennsylvania and draw resources from a strong
- 3 Statewide network and nationwide system; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Each year, Pennsylvania IRCs work with manufacturers
- 5 to innovate, grow profitable sales and create jobs in
- 6 Pennsylvania; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Many thousands of manufacturing chief executive
- 8 officers use Pennsylvania IRCs to keep up with the challenges of
- 9 their global markets, new innovations in products and processes,
- 10 increasing diversity in the work force, as well as the changing
- 11 landscape of government resources and regulations; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania IRCs play a liaison role between the
- 13 business community, economic development partners, elected
- 14 officials and manufacturing leaders and policy-makers; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Collectively, Pennsylvania IRCs impact the regional
- 16 economy by improving profitability, creating jobs and
- 17 reinvesting in businesses; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The economic impact of services provided by
- 19 Pennsylvania IRCs over the last 10 years equated to
- 20 \$7,395,185,729 in increased and retained sales, \$942,317,977 in
- 21 cost savings and \$1,443,369,811 in investments made; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania IRCs have supported the creation and
- 23 retention of 59,029 jobs in this Commonwealth over the last 10
- 24 years; and
- 25 WHEREAS, The IRCs are:
- 26 (1) the Commonwealth's only program dedicated to
- 27 manufacturing and making Pennsylvania a global leader in
- 28 manufacturing;
- 29 (2) the largest contributor to gross State product;
- 30 (3) the employer of well over half a million people in

- 1 Pennsylvania; and
- 2 (4) providing a high, family sustaining annual average
- 3 wage of \$55,243;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, A highly advanced, globally competitive base of
- 6 manufacturers is critical to the future and economic growth of
- 7 Pennsylvania; and
- 8 WHEREAS, In fiscal year 2011-2012, 780 of the hundreds of
- 9 manufacturers the seven IRCs work with were independently
- 10 surveyed, generating reported impact including \$718,542,750 in
- 11 sales increased and retained, \$90,358,032 in savings,
- 12 \$106,257,754 in investment and 4,955 jobs created and retained;
- 13 therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize March 13, 2013, as
- 15 "Pennsylvania Industrial Resource Centers (IRCs) Day" in
- 16 Pennsylvania, salute the exemplary contributions Pennsylvania
- 17 IRCs have made to the citizens and businesses of this
- 18 Commonwealth and extend best wishes for continued leadership and
- 19 service in the years to come.
