A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of July 21 through 27, 2013, as "Probation,
2 Parole and Community Supervision Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Community corrections is an essential part of the
4 justice system; and

5 WHEREAS, Community corrections professionals uphold the law
6 with dignity, while recognizing the right of the public to be
7 safeguarded from criminal activity; and

8 WHEREAS, The responsibilities of community corrections
9 professionals include the supervision of adult and juvenile
10 offenders in the community; and

11 WHEREAS, The community corrections professionals are trained
12 professionals who provide services and referrals for offenders;

14 WHEREAS, Working in partnership with community agencies and
15 groups, community corrections professionals promote prevention,
16 intervention and advocacy; and

17 WHEREAS, Community corrections professionals provide

1 services, support and protection for victims and advocate
2 community and restorative justice; and

3 WHEREAS, Community corrections professionals are a true force
4 for positive change in their communities; therefore be it

5 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of July 21
6 through 27, 2013, as "Probation, Parole and Community
7 Supervision Week" in Pennsylvania and encourage all citizens to
8 honor these professionals and recognize their achievements.
