A RESOLUTION

- Designating February 11, 2014, as "Housing Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth provides in excess of 200,000
- 4 subsidized, assisted or affordable rental dwelling units within
- 5 its boundaries, funded through Federal and State programs,
- 6 including, but not limited to, public housing, multifamily
- 7 housing, the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program and
- 8 others, with an additional 43,000 affordable housing units
- 9 having been developed through the Low Income Housing Tax Credit
- 10 Program; and
- 11 WHEREAS, There continues to be a demand for even more
- 12 affordable housing for low-income families, senior citizens,
- 13 veterans and individuals with physical and mental challenges;
- 14 and
- 15 WHEREAS, The provision of safe, secure, accessible and
- 16 affordable housing greatly impacts the lives of these
- 17 individuals; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Subsidized, assisted and affordable housing improves

- 1 the socioeconomic climate of this Commonwealth by benefiting not
- 2 only the residents, but also their neighbors, local businesses,
- 3 employers and their communities as a whole; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Creating awareness of the needs and the benefits of
- 5 housing assistance is essential to the growth and stability of
- 6 those who are served; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Association of Housing and
- 8 Redevelopment Agencies, in partnership with the Housing Alliance
- 9 of Pennsylvania, works closely with their members and industry
- 10 partners to build, develop, support and provide suitable housing
- 11 and related services; therefore be it
- 12 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate February 11, 2014, as
- 13 "Housing Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
