A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the month of April 2014 as "Multiple Birth Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Multiples of America, also known as the National
- 4 Organization of Mothers of Twins Clubs, Inc., has joined with
- 5 local organizations to establish and celebrate April as National
- 6 Multiple Birth Awareness Month; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The number of live births in twin deliveries in 2011
- 8 was approximately 131,269 births, and there were also 5,137
- 9 triplets, 239 quadruplets and 41 higher-order multiples born
- 10 nationwide; and
- 11 WHEREAS, With the increase in multiple births, there is an
- 12 increased risk for the mothers and babies; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Nationally, one out of every eight twins and one of
- 14 every three triplets are born very preterm, compared with fewer
- 15 than two of every 100 single births, and death during infancy is
- 16 four times more common for twins than singletons; and
- 17 WHEREAS, This month will be used to spread awareness about
- 18 the issues that families of multiple births face, including what

- 1 to know when expecting multiples, such as twin-to-twin
- 2 transfusion syndrome and other fetal issues directly affecting
- 3 multiple-birth pregnancies, premature births and low-birth
- 4 weights, multiples with special needs, the exceptional physical
- 5 and bonding demands placed on parents and the separation of
- 6 multiples in classrooms; and
- 7 WHEREAS, There are many local support groups for parents of
- 8 multiples and many of these clubs are planning events throughout
- 9 their communities during this month to celebrate their families,
- 10 increase participation and help out other families in need; and
- 11 WHEREAS, By raising awareness of multiple births, this month
- 12 also encourages parents of multiples, or who are expecting
- 13 multiples, to seek out the resources and support found with
- 14 local Mothers of Twins Clubs, through their prenatal care
- 15 provider, pediatrician, local hospital or friends and family;
- 16 and
- 17 WHEREAS, These clubs are established to serve parents or
- 18 quardians of multiple-birth children through education, research
- 19 and fellowship; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The Senate joins with the many parents of multiples
- 21 to celebrate the joys and challenges they face in raising their
- 22 twins, triplets or higher-order multiples and supports efforts
- 23 to educate our communities on the needs and challenges of
- 24 multiple-birth children; therefore be it
- 25 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize and celebrate the month
- 26 of April 2014 as "Multiple Birth Awareness Month" in
- 27 Pennsylvania.
