## A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating May 9, 2014, as "Military Spouse Day" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Since the early days of the Continental Army, the
4	spouses of servicemen and servicewomen have made unselfish
5	contributions to the well-being of their fighting spouses and
6	the general welfare of their communities; and
7	WHEREAS, Throughout the years, as the number of married men
8	and women in uniform has grown and as their military missions
9	have become more complex, their spouses have made countless
10	personal sacrifices to support the armed forces; and
11	WHEREAS, In 1984, President Ronald Reagan created Military
12	Spouse Day in recognition of the importance of spouse commitment
13	to the soldiers and military communities; and
14	WHEREAS, Military spouses often endure long separations from
15	their loved ones; and
16	WHEREAS, Military spouses are left to single-handedly take

1 care of their children and homes, as well as their careers; and 2 WHEREAS, As volunteers, military spouses have provided 3 exemplary service and leadership in educational, community, 4 recreational, religious, social and cultural endeavors; and 5 WHEREAS, On Military Spouse Day and throughout the year, we 6 honor the commitment military spouses make to their loved ones; 7 therefore be it

8 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate May 9, 2014, as "Military9 Spouse Day" in Pennsylvania.
