AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 24, 1976 (P.L.424, No.101), entitled,
- as amended, "An act providing for the payment of death
- benefits to the surviving spouse or children or parents of
- firefighters, ambulance service or rescue squad members, law
- 5 enforcement officers or National Guard members who die as a
- result of the performance of their duties," providing for the
- 7 payment of death benefits to members of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Civil Air Patrol.
- 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- 11 Section 1. Section 1(a), (a.1), (c) and (e) of the act of
- 12 June 24, 1976 (P.L.424, No.101), referred to as the Emergency
- 13 and Law Enforcement Personnel Death Benefits Act, amended
- 14 October 9, 2009 (P.L.588, No.51), are amended to read:
- 15 Section 1. (a) In the event a law enforcement officer,
- 16 ambulance service or rescue squad member, firefighter, certified
- 17 hazardous material response team member, member of the
- 18 Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol or National Guard member dies as a
- 19 result of the performance of his duties, such political
- 20 subdivision, Commonwealth agency or, in the case of National

- 1 Guard members, the Adjutant General, or, in the case of a member
- 2 of a Commonwealth law enforcement agency, the authorized
- 3 survivor or the agency head, within [90 days] three years from
- 4 the date of death, shall submit certification of such death to
- 5 the Commonwealth.
- 6 (a.1) A firefighter, ambulance service or rescue squad
- 7 member, law enforcement officer, certified hazardous material
- 8 response team member, member of the Pennsylvania Civil Air
- 9 Patrol or National Guard member who suffers a fatal heart attack
- 10 or stroke while on duty or not later than 24 hours after
- 11 participating in a physical training exercise or responding to
- 12 an emergency is presumed to have died as a result of the
- 13 performance of his duties for purposes of this act.
- 14 * * *
- 15 (c) A volunteer ambulance service, certified hazardous
- 16 material response team or rescue squad member or member of the
- 17 Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol shall be deemed to be acting in
- 18 the performance of his duties for the purposes of this act going
- 19 to or directly returning from an emergency which the ambulance
- 20 service, certified hazardous material response team [or]_ rescue
- 21 squad or member of the Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol attended
- 22 including travel from and direct return to an ambulance service,
- 23 certified hazardous material response team [or], rescue squad or
- 24 Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol member's home, place of business
- 25 or other place where he or she shall have been when he or she
- 26 received the call or alarm or while participating in drills in
- 27 which the ambulance service, certified hazardous material
- 28 response team [or], rescue squad or Pennsylvania Civil Air_
- 29 Patrol shall have participated or while repairing or doing other
- 30 work about or on any emergency vehicle or buildings and grounds

- 1 of the ambulance service, certified hazardous material response
- 2 team [or], rescue squad or Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol upon
- 3 the authorization of the chief of the ambulance service,
- 4 certified hazardous material response team [or], rescue squad or
- 5 <u>Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol</u> or other person in charge while
- 6 answering any emergency calls for any purpose or while riding
- 7 upon any vehicles which are owned or used by the ambulance
- 8 service, certified hazardous material response team [or] rescue
- 9 squad <u>or Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol</u>.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (e) The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall pay out of the
- 12 General Fund to the surviving spouse or, if there is no
- 13 surviving spouse, the minor children of a National Guard member,
- 14 certified hazardous material response team member, member of the
- 15 Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol, volunteer firefighter, ambulance
- 16 service or rescue squad member who died as a result of the
- 17 performance of his duties the sum of \$100,000, adjusted in
- 18 accordance with subsection (f) of this section. When no spouse
- 19 or minor children survive, the benefit shall be paid to the
- 20 parent or parents of such National Guard member, certified
- 21 hazardous material response team member, member of the
- 22 <u>Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol</u>, volunteer firefighter, ambulance
- 23 service or rescue squad member. The benefit shall be payable
- 24 whether or not the National Guard member or certified hazardous
- 25 material response team member, member of the Pennsylvania Civil
- 26 Air Patrol, volunteer firefighter, ambulance service or rescue
- 27 squad member died as a result of the performance of his duty
- 28 within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
