AN ACT
Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in juries and jurors, further providing for exemptions from jury duty and for list of disqualified jurors.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section $4503(a)$ of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding paragraphs to read: § 4503. Exemptions from jury duty.
(a) General rule.--No person shall be exempt or excused from jury duty except the following:

*     *         * 

(6) Persons 75 years of age or older who opt not to serve.
(7) Breastfeeding women providing the court with a certified letter from their physician which states that the woman is breastfeeding. An excuse under this paragraph shall be valid for one year and may be renewed for one additional

9 (c) Persons aged 75 vears or older.--A person who is exempt 10 or excused from jury duty under section 4503 (a) (6) (relating to 11 exemptions from jury duty) may petition the jury selection 12 commission to have the person's name placed on the list of 13 disqualified jurors. A person placed on the list may, at any 14 time, petition for removal of the person's name from the list 15 unless the person is disqualified under section 4502 (relating 16 to qualifications of jurors).

(c) Persons aged 75 vears or older.--A person who is exempt
