Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in municipal authorities, further 2 providing for transfer of existing facilities to authority 3 AND PROVIDING FOR SALE OR TRANSFER OF AUTHORITY WATER OR SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 5613(b) of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania 8 9 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 10 § 5613. Transfer of existing facilities to authority. 11 * * * (b) Acquisition. --12 13 An authority may not acquire by any device or means, 14 including a consolidation, merger, purchase or lease or 15 through the purchase of stock, bonds or other securities, 16 title to or possession or use of all or a substantial portion 17 of any existing facilities constituting a project [as defined under this chapter] if the project is subject to the 18

jurisdiction of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission

- without first reporting to and advising the municipality
 which created or which are members of the authority of the
 agreement to acquire, including all its terms and conditions.
- The proposed action of the authority and the 4 (2) 5 proposed agreement to acquire shall be approved by the 6 governing body of the municipality which created or which are 7 members of the authority and to which the report is made. 8 Where there are one or two member municipalities of the 9 authority, such approval shall be by two-thirds vote of all of the members of the governing body or of each of the 10 governing bodies. If there are more than two member 11 12 municipalities of the authority, approval shall be by 13 majority vote of all the members of each governing body of 14 two-thirds of the member municipalities.
- 15 (3) An authority may not acquire by a device or means, including a consolidation, merger, purchase or lease or 16 through the purchase of stock, bonds or other security, title 17 18 to or possession or use of all or a substantial portion of a 19 facility constituting a project, unless the authority has 20 discussed the acquisition at a public meeting and the written 21 minutes of the meeting contain details relating to the 22 anticipated or projected public benefit that will be realized 23 by the acquisition. For purposes of this paragraph, a public 24 benefit may include rate reduction, improved service quality, 25 improved service reliability or other clearly defined benefit 26 to a ratepayer of the authority.

- 29 § 5613.1. SALE OR TRANSFER OF AUTHORITY WATER OR SEWER

- 1 (A) PROHIBITION.--AN AUTHORITY MAY NOT SELL OR TRANSFER
- 2 TITLE TO ALL OR A PORTION OF THE WATER OR SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE
- 3 OF THE AUTHORITY, UNLESS THE AUTHORITY HAS DISCUSSED THE SALE OR
- 4 TRANSFER AT A PUBLIC MEETING AND THE WRITTEN MINUTES OF THE
- 5 MEETING CONTAIN DETAILS RELATING TO THE ANTICIPATED OR PROJECTED
- 6 PUBLIC BENEFIT THAT WILL BE REALIZED BY THE SALE OR TRANSFER.
- 7 (B) DEFINITION. -- AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE TERM "PUBLIC"
- 8 BENEFIT" MAY INCLUDE A RATE REDUCTION, IMPROVED SERVICE QUALITY,
- 9 IMPROVED SERVICE RELIABILITY OR OTHER CLEARLY DEFINED BENEFIT TO
- 10 A RATEPAYER OF THE AUTHORITY.
- 11 Section $\frac{2}{3}$. The addition of 53 Pa.C.S. § 5613(b)(3) shall <--
- 12 apply to title to or possession or use of all or a substantial
- 13 portion of a facility constituting a project which is acquired
- 14 on or after the effective date of this section.
- 15 SECTION 4. THE ADDITION OF 53 PA.C.S. § 5613.1 SHALL APPLY <--
- 16 TO THE SALE OR TRANSFER OF TITLE TO ALL OR A PORTION OF THE
- 17 WATER OR SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE SOLD OR TRANSFERRED ON OR AFTER
- 18 THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION.
- 19 Section $\frac{3}{2}$ 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days. <--
