Amending the act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317, No.69), entitled, as 1 amended, "An act relating to the practice of professional 2 nursing; providing for the licensing of nurses and for the 3 revocation and suspension of such licenses, subject to appeal, and for their reinstatement; providing for the renewal of such licenses; regulating nursing in general; prescribing penalties and repealing certain laws," further 5 6 7 providing for refusal, suspension or revocation of licenses. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. Section 14(a)(8) of the act of May 22, 1951 12 (P.L.317, No.69), known as The Professional Nursing Law, amended 13 June 29, 2002 (P.L.651, No.99), is amended to read: 14 Section 14. Refusal, Suspension or Revocation of Licenses .--The Board may refuse, suspend or revoke any license in any 15 16 case where the Board shall find that --* * * 17 The licensee possessed, used, acquired or distributed a 18 19 controlled substance or caution legend drug for other than an acceptable medical purpose. If the licensee is convicted of an 20
