- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes, in offenses against the family, further providing for the offense of dealing in infant 3

- hereby enacts as follows: 6
- Section 1. Section 4305 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- § 4305. Dealing in infant children.
- (a) Offense defined. -- A person is quilty of a [misdemeanor] 10
- felony of the first degree if he deals in humanity, by trading, 11
- bartering, buying, selling, or dealing in infant children. 12
- 13 (b) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the term "infant
- child" means a child one year of age and under. 14
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 15
