AN ACT

1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in restructuring of electric utility
3 industry, further providing for duties of electric
4 distribution companies.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 2807(f)(3) of Title 66 of the
8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

9 § 2807. Duties of electric distribution companies.

10 * * *

11 (f) Smart meter technology and time of use rates.--

12 * * *

13 (3) Electric distribution companies shall, with customer
14 consent, make available direct meter access and electronic
15 access to customer meter data to third parties, including
16 electric generation suppliers [and], providers of
17 conservation and load management services[.] and government
18 agencies. Notwithstanding the foregoing, customer consent

1 shall not be required when:

2 (i) the information is released to comply with a
3 subpoena or order issued by a court or regulatory agency;

4 (ii) the information is released on a confidential
5 basis in the context of an administrative proceeding
6 involving a customer complaint;

7 (iii) the information is released in aggregated
8 form; or

9 (iv) there is an emergency situation involving an
10 imminent threat to public health or safety.

12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
